

Report on Orientation Program for Phase II MBBS Students (2024 Admission Batch)

The Orientation Program for Phase II MBBS students (2024 admission batch) was organized by the Amala Institute of Medical Sciences on the 21st and 22nd of October 2025 at the MEU Hall. The two-day program was designed to facilitate the smooth transition of students from pre-clinical to para-clinical and clinical phases, providing guidance on academic expectations, clinical exposure, and the value systems that form the foundation of medical practice.

The first day of the program, held on 21st October 2025, began at 9:00 a.m. with a session on “Introduction to Phase II,” led by Dr. Deepti Ramakrishnan, Phase Coordinator and Vice Principal. She oriented the students on the objectives, curriculum, learning methods, and assessment strategies of the new phase.

This was followed by the inaugural ceremony at 10:00 a.m., which commenced with a prayer by the Phase II students. The welcome address was delivered by Dr. Subi Das, Associate Professor, Department of Microbiology, and Class Teacher of Phase II. The inaugural address and lamp lighting were performed by Rev. Fr. Julious Arakkal CMI, Director of Amala Institute of Medical Sciences. Felicitations were offered by Rev. Fr. Antony Mannummel CMI, Associate Director, Dr. Betsy Thomas, Principal, and Dr. Deepti Ramakrishnan, Vice Principal and Phase Coordinator. Dr. Betsy Thomas, Principal, introduced the Heads of the Departments of Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Community Medicine, and Forensic Medicine, along with the YIP Nodal Officer and the Director of the AIMRD Research Laboratory. The vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Anusha Bose, Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacology. This was followed by a brief introduction to the mentoring system by Dr. Subi Das.

The next session, from 10:45 a.m. to 12:15 p.m., focused on “History Taking: Format and Bedside Manners,” conducted by Dr. Anish S, Associate Professor, Department of General Medicine. The session highlighted the importance of empathy, patient communication, and professionalism in clinical practice.

The afternoon sessions began at 1:00 p.m., with students divided into two main groups, Batch 1 and Batch 2, each further subdivided into smaller groups for practical training. Various interactive sessions were held, including Basic Life Support (BLS) training by Dr. Jobin Jose Maprani, Professor and Head of the Department of Emergency Medicine; sessions on Communication and Patient Scenarios by Dr. (Lt. Col.) B. Vipin, Assistant Professor, Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, and Dr. Antony Kalliath, Senior Resident, Department of Emergency Medicine. IGNITE, a motivative and innovative session by Dr. Kayeen Vadakkan, Scientist-C, AIMRD was also conducted. The day also included a session on Hospital Infection Control (HIC) practical aspects by Dr. Maria Thomas, Assistant Professor, Department of Microbiology, and HIC Officer. The sessions aimed to strengthen clinical readiness and team-based learning among students.

The second day of the orientation, held on 22nd October 2025, began at 8:00 a.m. with a session on “Value System in MBBS” by Dr. Rupesh George, Associate Professor, Department of Cardiology, emphasizing the ethical and humanistic dimensions of medical education. This was followed by a session on the “Learner Doctor Method” by Dr. Kalyani Pillai, Professor and Head, Department of Paediatrics, who elaborated on the active learning and problem-solving approach expected in clinical years.

An interactive session with Amala Alumni, including Dr. Rakesh L. John, Dr. Febin Antony, Dr. Sneha Georgy, Dr. Sangeetha Sajeevu, Dr. Tom Philip, and Dr. Hisana Thasnim, provided students with valuable insights into their experiences, career development, and lessons learned in clinical practice. The students were encouraged to engage in self-directed learning and professional growth.

Following this, a session on “IQAC and Accreditations of Amala” was conducted by Rev. Fr. Deljo Puthoor CMI, Joint Director and Dr. Deepti Ramakrishnan, IQAC Coordinator. The speakers emphasized the importance of continuous quality improvement, institutional accreditation processes, and the role of students in maintaining academic excellence and institutional integrity.

After the lunch break, the afternoon sessions resumed, mirroring the first day’s practical format. Students participated in Basic Life Support training, communication and patient scenario workshops, IGNITE sessions, and HIC practical modules. These interactive and skill-based sessions aimed to equip students with the foundational clinical competencies and teamwork skills necessary for Phase II.

Overall, the two-day orientation program was an enriching and inspiring experience that helped the Phase II MBBS students adapt to the demands of their new academic phase. Through a blend of academic sessions, skill-building workshops, and interactive discussions, the program provided clarity, confidence, and motivation to students as they embarked on the next stage of their medical journey.

The program was coordinated under the leadership of Dr. Deepti Ramakrishnan, Vice Principal and Phase Coordinator, with overall guidance from the Principal, Dr. Betsy Thomas, and the administrative support of the institution. The event was successfully conducted with active participation from faculty members, resource persons, and students, marking a significant beginning to the Phase II learning experience at Amala Institute of Medical Sciences.


