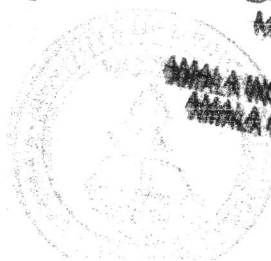
Instructions to students



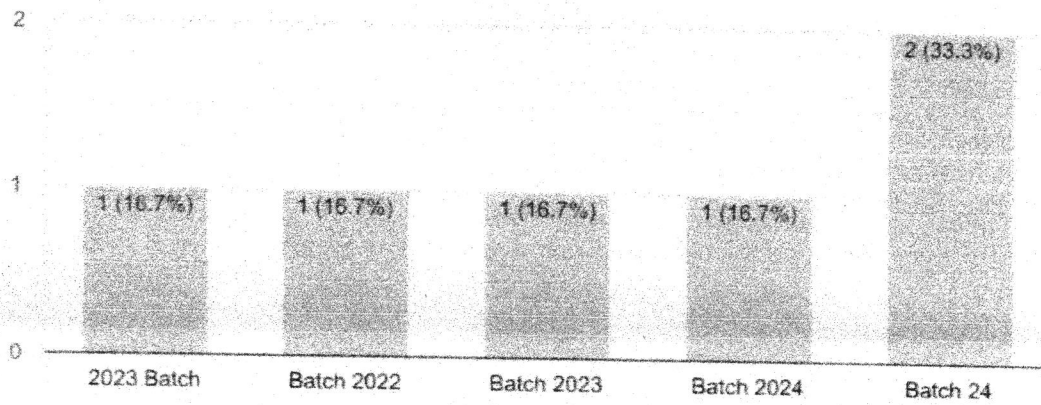

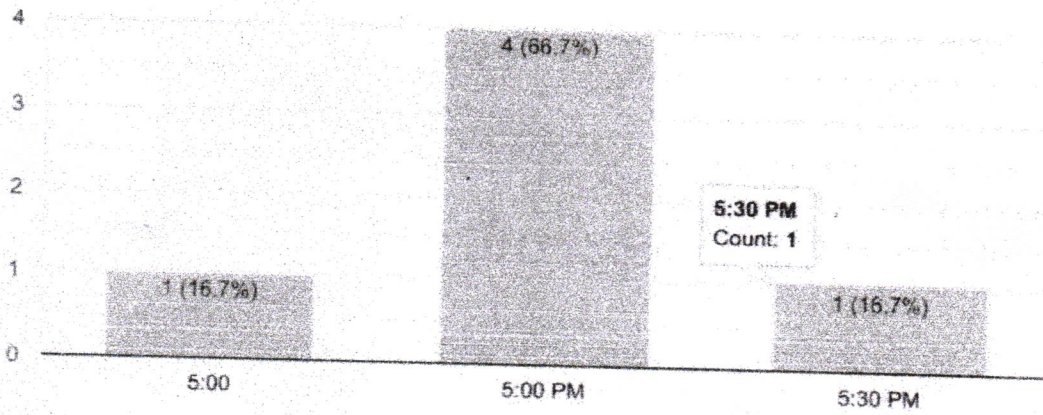
