RULES & REGULATIONS

- The quiz is open to all medical students, including house surgeons, registered for the event.
- Each team must consist of two members from the same college. Cross-college teams are not permitted.
- The competition will be held in two stages – prelims (forenoon) and finals (afternoon).
- Both rounds will feature a diverse set of questions covering medical disciplines, related general knowledge, and significant historical and cultural milestones in medicine.
- The prelims will be a written test supplemented with audio-visual components.
- The top 8 teams from the prelims will qualify for the finals.
- Finals will be conducted in an elimination format
- In case of disputes, the quiz master's decision will be final and binding.

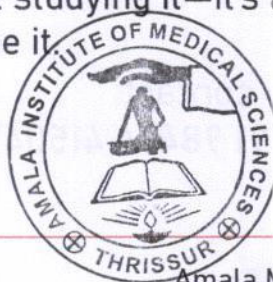

Rare cases are not entertained.

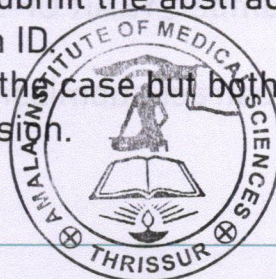
Eligibility: phase 2, phase 3 part 1 and 2 and HS

- 2020,2021,2022,2023, 2024 batches

Individual or team of 2 (no cross-college teams allowed).

For team registration, both members should complete basic delegate registration prior to abstract submission. In the abstract submission portal, the presenting participant should submit the abstract along with their team member's assigned registration ID.

Only one participant is allowed to present the case but both members are allowed to participate in the Q & A session.



GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT

Abstract must be in the following format:

1. Title
2. History
3. Examination findings
4. Provisional / differential diagnosis
5. Investigations
6. Management
7. Learning points for MBBS students

- Word limit: 500
- Font: Times New Roman
- Font size: 12
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Abstract should be uploaded as a word document.

Only one abstract can be submitted by a participant.

The abstract must be accompanied by a letter from the Head of the Department attesting that the given case is from a true patient in their respective hospital.

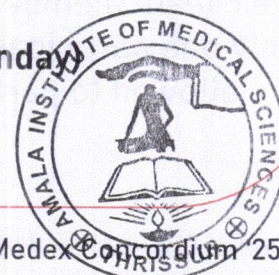
The abstract will be rejected in case of any form of plagiarism or malpractice.

The abstract should not contain any personal information or other unethical content.

The abstract must be uploaded through the website.

Name of the document should be given in following format:
'RegistrationNumber_YEAR OF STUDY_ SUBJECT'

Last date for abstract submission: **October 26, 2025 (Sunday)**



GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTATION

- Selected candidates will be informed through their registered email address.
- Participants selected for finals should prepare a PowerPoint presentation titled 'RegistrationNumber_YEAR OF STUDY_SUBJECT' and upload it to the given website portal.
- Last date for submission of presentation is 18th November 2025.
- The PowerPoint presentation should also follow the same format as that of Abstract.
- Include images if relevant and required for case presentation.
- Time limit: 5 min for presentation and 5 min for discussion.

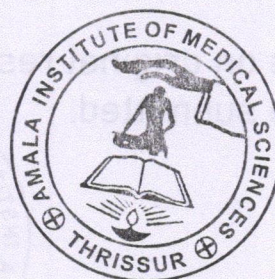

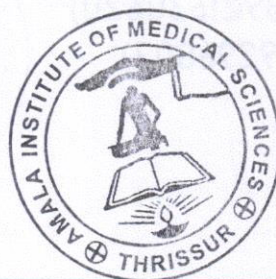

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Abstracts should be submitted online following registration
Format of Abstract:

- Font: Times New Roman
- Font size: 12
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Abstract should be uploaded as a word document.
- Name of the document should be given in following format:
RegistrationNumber_Spectra'

Scientific abstracts on original research, review articles and case series may be submitted.



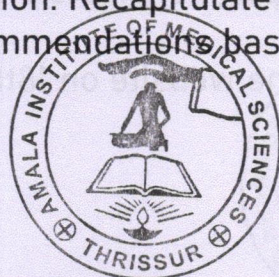
Abstracts should be structured as Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusion and must be within the word count of 250 words.

- Only one abstract can be sent by a participant.
- All submitted abstracts will undergo a review process by the scientific committee and the committee will decide the mode of presentation.
- The decision made by the scientific committee with regard to mode of presentation will be final and will be announced on 11th November, 2025
- The presenting author should have registered for the conference. Only one person will be allowed to present at the conference. Only the presenting author will be given the certificate of presentation.
- Studies that have already been presented at any other conference or seminar are not eligible for submission, regardless of whether they have won a prize or not.
- All abstracts should be submitted via the online submission form ONLY. Other modes of submission will not be entertained.

FORMAT FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION - FREE PAPER/POSTER PRESENTATION

Please follow a structured format, indicating the following six parts of your abstract.

1. Title:- Concise and catchy title.
2. Introduction: - Provide the background and context of the problem or issue.
3. Objectives: - Clearly state the purpose or goal of the study
4. Methods: - Describe the procedures and techniques used to conduct the study
5. Results: - Summarize the findings and outcomes
6. Conclusion: Recapitulate the main findings and offer suggestions or recommendations based on the results.



- Limit the text to 250 words excluding Title, Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusion.
- Please ensure the following details are present below the title:
Presenting author, name and designation of guide, department, name of institution, state
- Each abstract must be complete i.e., it must include all information necessary for its comprehension and not refer to another text.
- The last date for Abstract Submission is 26th October 2025, Sunday
- You will be notified if your abstract has been selected for free paper/poster on 11th November 2025

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF FREE PAPER

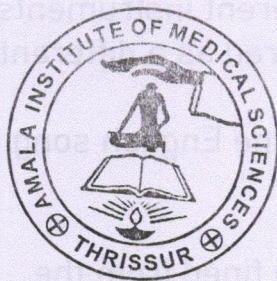
- The presentation must be prepared for a total time of 5 minutes. This will be followed by 2 minutes for Questions & Answers.
- File format- Microsoft Power point – 10-12 slides/presentation
- The presentation should be in the format of Title,
- Introduction, Objective, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion and add References.
- Slides need to be prepared in the given template design with 8 lines per each slide.
- Pictures, graphs and tables can be included.
- Videos & music are not allowed.
- Each session will have Session Chairpersons.
- Please note that the Session Chairperson has the right to terminate your running presentation in case you exceed the allotted time of 5 min.
- The candidate's registration number needs to be included in the first slide along with the title of the study.
- The candidate's name, Institution's name and name of the guide are not allowed in the title page.
- The presentation must be saved as 'Free paper_Candidate's RegNumber.pptx'
- The free paper ppt should be uploaded via the website on 18th November 2025.



GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF E-POSTER

- The poster must be in English with Times New Roman font.
The slide must be in landscape view; slide size 16:9 (widescreen)
- A single slide must be prepared containing the presentation in the format of Title, Introduction, Objective, Methods, Results and Conclusion.
- The candidate's registration number needs to be included along with the title of the study.
- The candidate's name, Institution's name and name of the guide are not allowed in the title page. The slide has to be saved and shared in the PDF format.
- The presentation must be saved as Poster_Candidate's register number.pdf.
- The E-poster PDF should be uploaded via the website on 18th November 2025
- The E-posters will be displayed at the conference and the candidates will be required to answer the questions posed by the judges. There will be no time allotted for podium presentations

(10 mins for setting up and 20 mins for performance)
3. A green light would be shown from the beginning of the performance which would shift to orange signifying the last 5 mins and red light at the end of 20 mins of 'Performance. If the performance exceeds the given time, only the performance within the time frame will be considered for judgements.
4. No pre-recorded tracks or use of built in rhythms are allowed. This will lead to immediate disqualification.
5. Each team should have a minimum of 4 different instruments. (Bass guitar if played on keyboard, can be considered as a different instrument)
6. Songs in any Indian language can be used. One English song is allowed.
7. Original Compositions are encouraged
8. Any damage to the college property shall be fined from the respective college.
