PREFACE

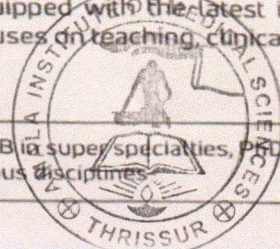

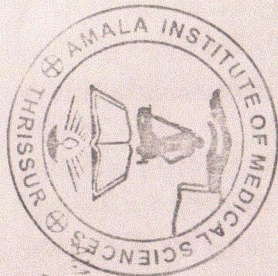
