As part of alumni engagement activities, **offline alumni interactions** were conducted on the following dates:

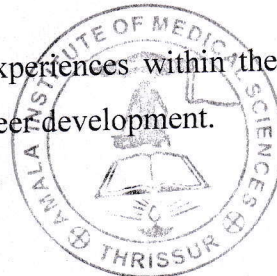
- **Dates:** 2 August 2025 and 11 September 2025

- Strengthened alumni network and coordination

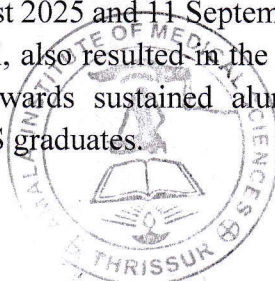
8. Future Plans

The UK Alumni Chapter plans to:

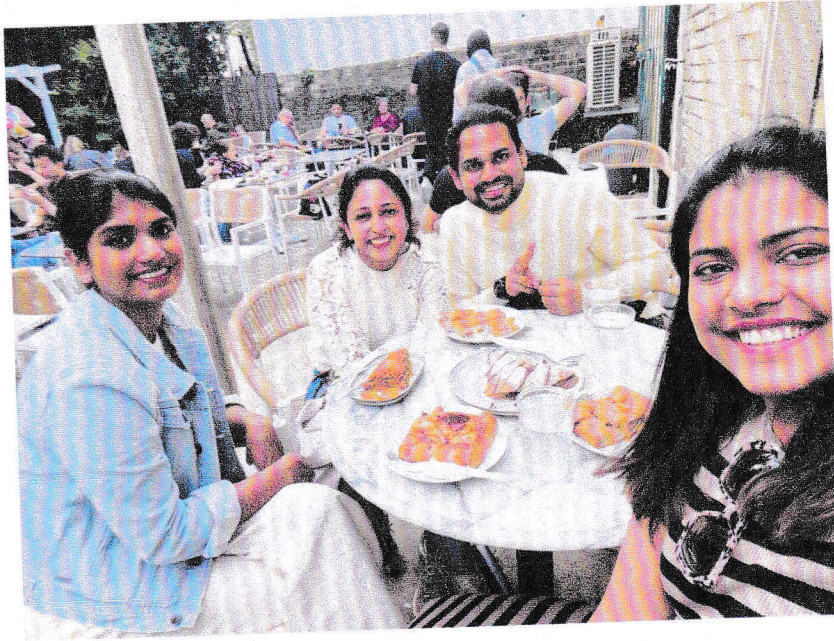
- Utilize the WhatsApp group for regular communication and updates

9. Conclusion

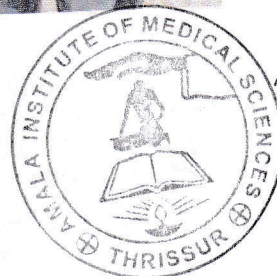
