For Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Dr. Kayeen Vadakkan, Scientist C, Amala Integrated Medical Research Department and for Carmel College (Autonomous), Dr. Sinjumol Thomas, Assistant Professor shall serve as liaison officers for this agreement.

Duration

This MoU is effective from the date of signing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MoU and the governing bodies of the party's respective counties and shall remain in full force and effect for 3 years.

Dispute Resolution

Any dispute between the parties will have to be resolved by a sole arbitrator appointed by the mutual consent.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

Any divergence or difference arising out of or derived from the interpretation or application of the Agreement shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

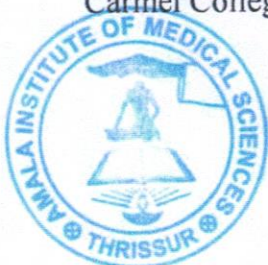
Amendment and Termination
