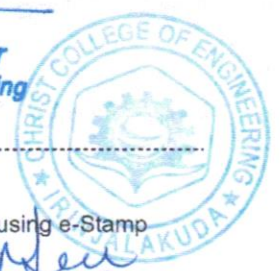

1. Purpose

- Individual department-wise MOUs with specific areas of collaboration and objectives and terms will be developed and executed between Christ College of Engineering and the corresponding departments of Amala Institute of Medical Sciences by the respective Department Heads.


2. Areas of Collaboration

On mutual discussion, this MoU envisage to encourage the development of the following academic and research collaborations based on their respective academic and educational needs:

A. Student Exchange Program

Both institutions agree to:

- Facilitate short-term or long-term exchange of undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- Support students in internships, project work, clinical exposure, research assistance, or interdisciplinary learning.
- Provide academic mentoring and technical support during the exchange.
- Permit access to campus, libraries, laboratories, and testing facilities.
- Offer joint certification for select academic or training programs.

B. Faculty and Staff Exchange Program

Both institutions agree to:

- Facilitate visits of faculty and technical staff for teaching, training, research, and mentoring.
- Encourage joint supervision of student projects and interdisciplinary collaboration.
- Organize seminars, workshops, conferences, guest lectures, expert sessions, and faculty development programs.
- Explore co-teaching opportunities and collaborative curriculum development.
- Invite each other's experts to participate in institutional academic activities.

C. Shared Use of Laboratory Facilities

Both institutions agree to:

- Permit mutually agreed access to laboratory and research infrastructure.
- Enable the use of specialized equipment for academic or research purposes.
- Coordinate scheduling, safety, and operational protocols.


D. Joint Research and Interdisciplinary Programs

Both institutions agree to:

- Initiate collaborative research in emerging and interdisciplinary domains.
- Apply for joint research funding and publish collaborative outcomes.
- Organize interdisciplinary workshops, conferences, and seminars.
- Outcomes, contributions and institutional recognition for collaborative research contributions and academic outcomes of each department generated under this MoU will be shared between Christ College of Engineering and Amala Institute of Medical Sciences.

3. Implementation and Coordination

- A Coordinating Committee comprising representatives from both institutions will be established.
- The committee will plan, monitor, and review all collaborative activities and resolve operational issues.

- The following departments of Christ College of Engineering will actively participate in this collaboration with Amala Institute of Medical Sciences by designating faculty representatives responsible for initiating and managing department-specific MoUs and collaborative programs, Also, the outcomes and contributions of collaborative research will be shared by Christ College of Engineering and Amala Institute of Medical Sciences will share the outcomes and contributions.

 - Department of Computer Science and Engineering (Business Systems).
 - Department of Civil Engineering.
 - Department of Mechanical Engineering.
 - Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering.
 - Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering.

4. Financial Arrangements

- Each institution will bear its own internal costs unless specified otherwise in project-specific agreements.
- Joint applications for external funding may be submitted where appropriate.

5. Duration


This MoU is effective from the date of signing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MoU and the governing bodies of the party's respective counts and shall remain in full force and effect for 3 years.

6. Amendment and Termination

- The MoU may be amended or renewed by mutual written consent.
- This MoU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon three month written notice, which shall be delivered by hand, electronically, or by certified mail to the address listed above.
- Ongoing activities shall be allowed to conclude under the terms agreed upon at initiation.


7. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute between the parties will have to be resolved by a sole arbitrator appointed by the mutual consent.

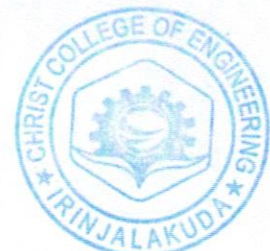

8. Confidentiality

The parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that maybe exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this MoU save where the same is already in public domain. The confidentiality obligations under this clause shall survive the termination of this MoU.

The parties can use shared intellectual property solely for academic and research purposes unless otherwise agreed in writing.

9. Governing Law and Jurisdiction


Any divergence or difference arising out of or derived from the interpretation or application of the Agreement shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

10. Miscellaneous


The parties recognize that the implementation of any exchange program will depend upon the academic interests and expertise of individual faculty members and upon the availability of financial resources. Accordingly, the implementation of any activities as detailed in above shall be separately negotiated by both institutions and set forth in a separate written document.

This agreement is not intended to be a legally binding document. It does not constitute any enforceable obligation. Its sole intention is to facilitate collaboration between two parties. It is meant to describe nature and to suggest the guidelines of the cooperation described above. Nothing therefore shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.

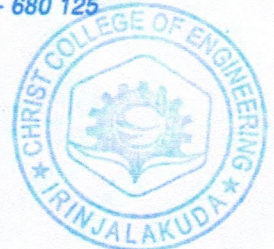

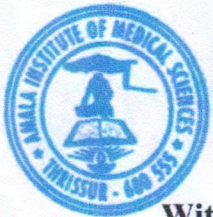
