1. Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is seeking to improve understanding between the respective academic institutions and to establish mutually beneficial collaborations benefiting their students and faculty.


2. Terms & Conditions

On mutual discussion, this MoU envisage to encourage the development of the following academic and research collaborations based on their respective academic and educational needs:


- Exchange of faculty
- Exchange of students and research scholars
- Organization of joint research programs
- Organization of joint conferences
- Organization of other academic exchanges agreeable to both institutions.
- Sharing library resources

The parties recognize that the implementation of any exchange program will depend upon the academic interests and expertise of individual faculty members and upon the availability of financial resources. Accordingly, the implementation of any activities as detailed in above shall be separately negotiated by both institutions and set forth in a separate written document.

This MoU is not intended to be a legally binding document. It is meant to describe nature and to suggest the guidelines of the cooperation described above. Nothing therefore shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.

3. Duration

This MoU is effective from the date of signing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MoU and shall remain in full force and effect for 3 years.

4. Financial Arrangements


The Parties acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement in writing to the contrary, each Party shall be responsible for its own costs and expenses in establishing and conducting programmes and activities contemplated under this MoU, including without limitation, travel and accommodation expenses.

5. Intellectual Property


- a) The Parties agree that any intellectual property rights arising from or in connection with any programme or activity under this MoU, through and by the joint and collaborative efforts of both Parties shall be jointly owned and subject to any other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon in writing.
- b) Both Parties shall acknowledge one another in any form of writing, publication or presentation based on research derived from the cooperative efforts of both Parties under this MoU, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing by the Parties.

6. Confidentiality

The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity

conducted pursuant to this MoU save where the same is already in public domain. The confidentiality obligations under this Clause shall survive the termination of this MoU.

7. Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute between the parties in respect of any rights or liabilities arising out of this MoU, the same shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator appointed by mutual consent and the proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions contained in the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

8. Governing Law

This MoU shall be governed by and construed according to the prevailing laws of Kerala. Both Parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Thrissur.

9. Termination & Amendment


This MoU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon one month written notice, which shall be delivered by hand, electronically, or by certified mail to the address listed above.

All modifications, clarifications and amendments to this MoU shall be in writing and signed by both parties.


10. Miscellaneous
