

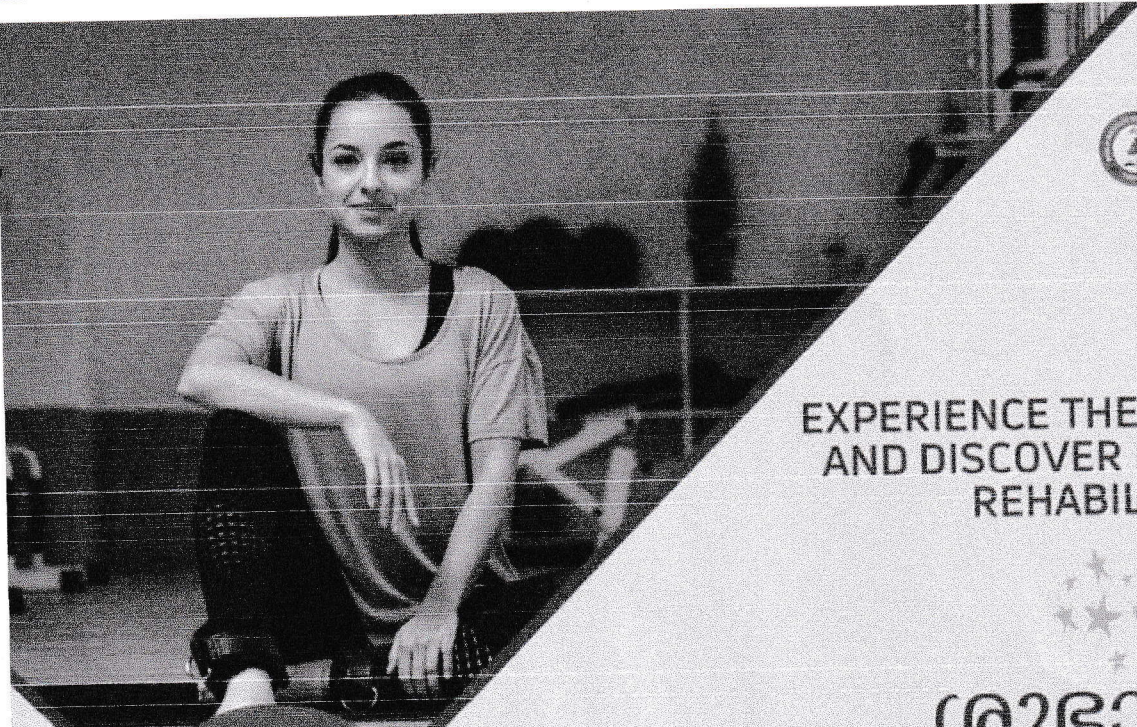

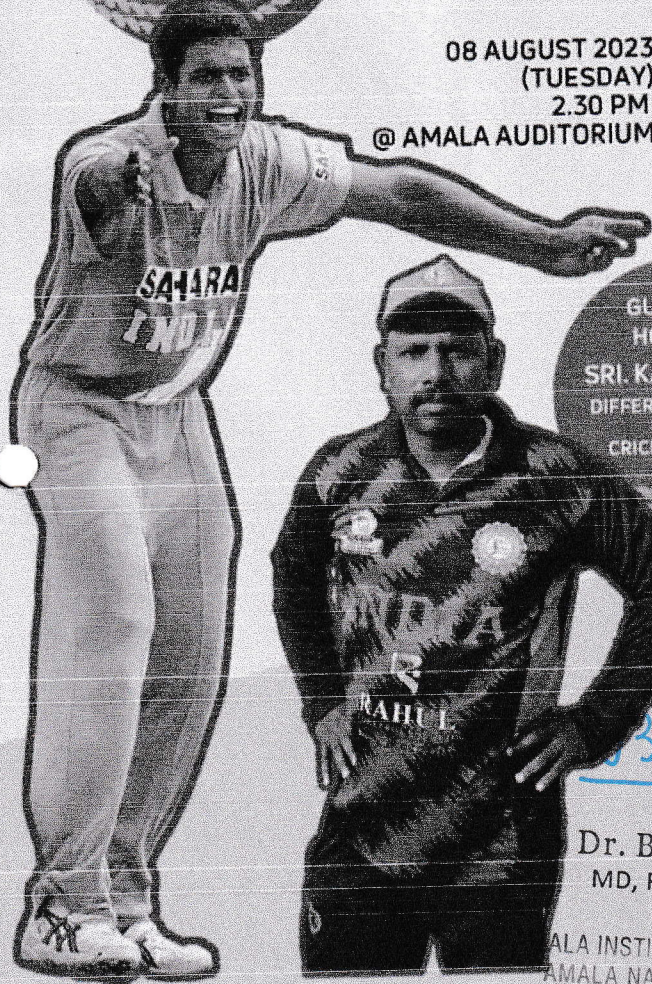

Multi-Disciplinary Camp

Camp registrations were started by 9.30 am and all children were seen by PMR specialists and Developmental Paediatricians. Based on their need, children were referred to other specialties and therapy services like Paediatric Neurology, Orthopaedics, Ophthalmology, ENT, Dental, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Developmental Therapy, Audiology and Speech Language Pathology, Psychology, Assistive Technology including Orthotics, Dietician, Special Educator, and Social Work.

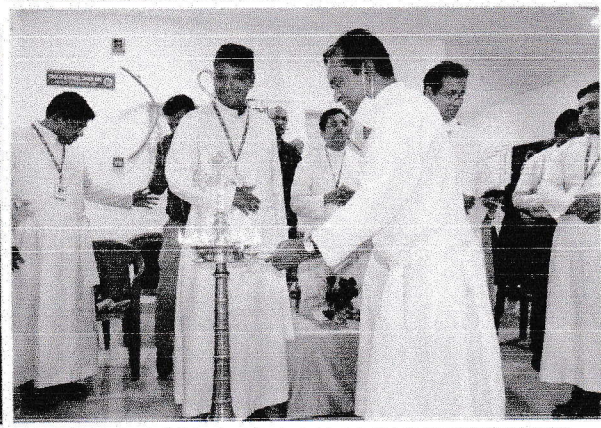
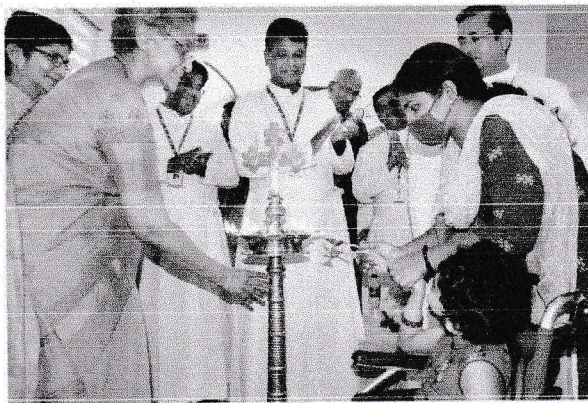
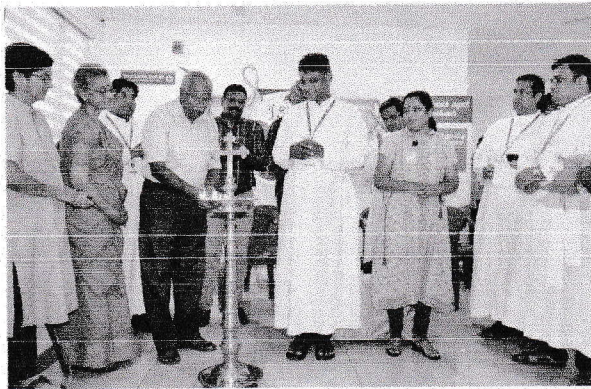
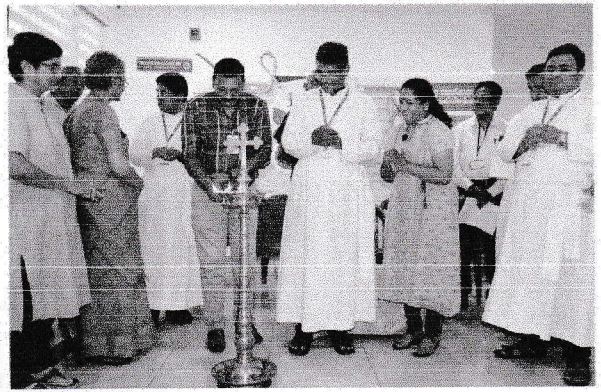
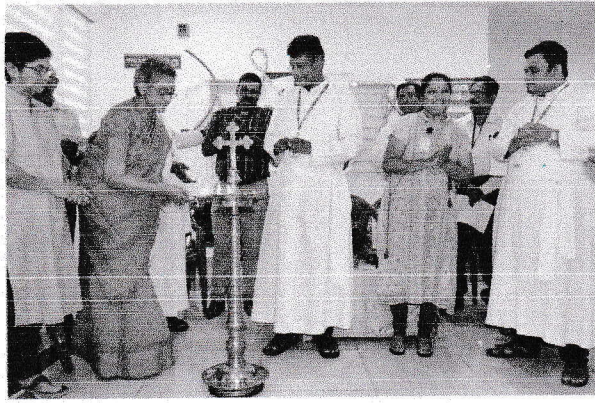
Paediatric Neurology services were provided by Dr. Darshan Jayaram, Rajagiri Hospital Aluva, who also interacted with P G students from Dept. Of Paediatrics.
