- Fostered collaboration between healthcare educators and law enforcement in promoting preventive messages.

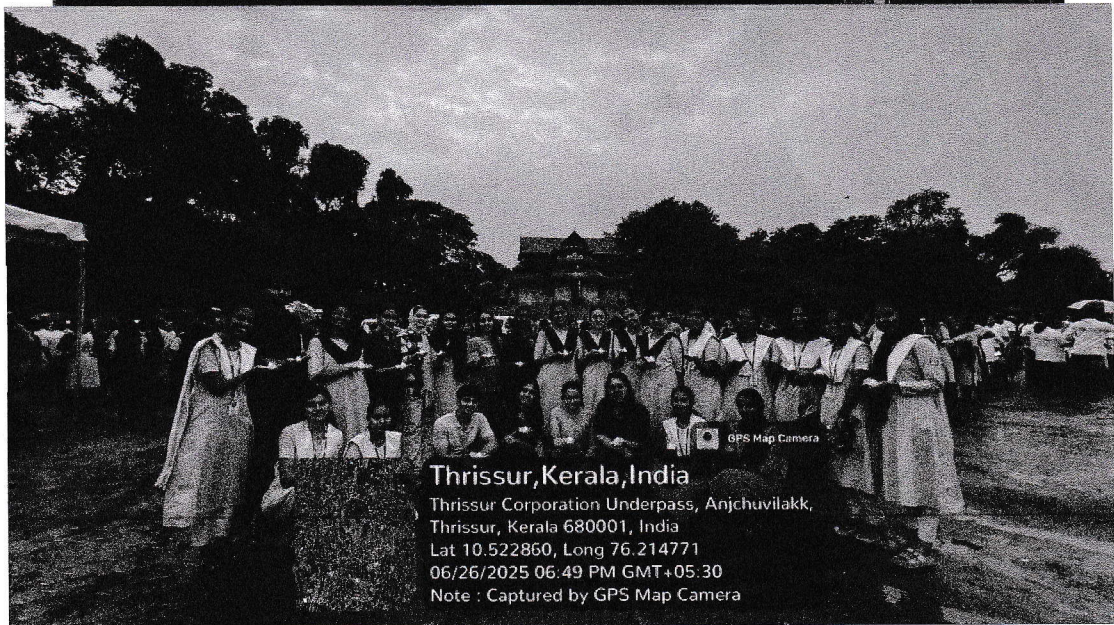
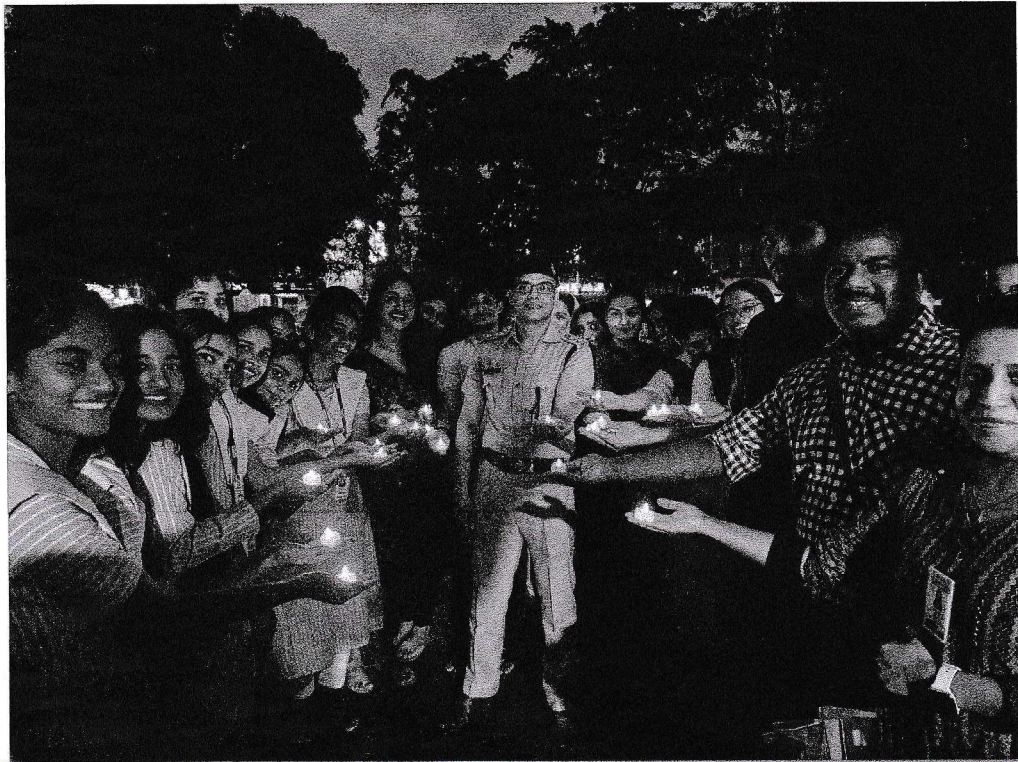

**Report on Community Medicine awareness programme:**

As part of the nationwide “100 Days TB Awareness Campaign,” a vibrant **Flash Mob** was organized on January 25, 2025, at the Skywalk near Shakthan Stand, Thrissur. The event featured **20 enthusiastic MBBS students from the 2024 batch** of Amala Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS), who showcased an energetic and engaging performance aimed at raising public awareness about **Tuberculosis (TB)**.

The Flash Mob drew the attention of the general public, commuters, and shopkeepers in the vicinity. The theme of the performance centered on TB prevention, early detection, treatment adherence, and reducing stigma associated with the disease. **Report on Community Medicine awareness programme:**

As part of ongoing health education initiatives, the Department of Community Medicine, AIMS, Thrissur, conducted a Tuberculosis (TB) awareness session for police officials at the Peramangalam Police Station on June 27, 2025. The session was attended by 15 police personnel.

The session was led by Dr. Sruthi C M, Assistant Professor, who provided valuable insights into the epidemiology, symptoms, modes of transmission, prevention, and treatment of tuberculosis. Emphasis was placed on early detection, adherence to treatment, and the importance of reducing stigma associated with the disease.

The program also addressed the occupational vulnerability of police officials due to frequent public contact and highlighted preventive strategies including respiratory hygiene and periodic health check-ups. Interactive discussions and clarification of doubts helped enhance participant engagement and understanding.

The session was well received and appreciated by the attendees. The event concluded with a vote of thanks from the station authorities, acknowledging the department's efforts in promoting public health awareness among law enforcement personnel.

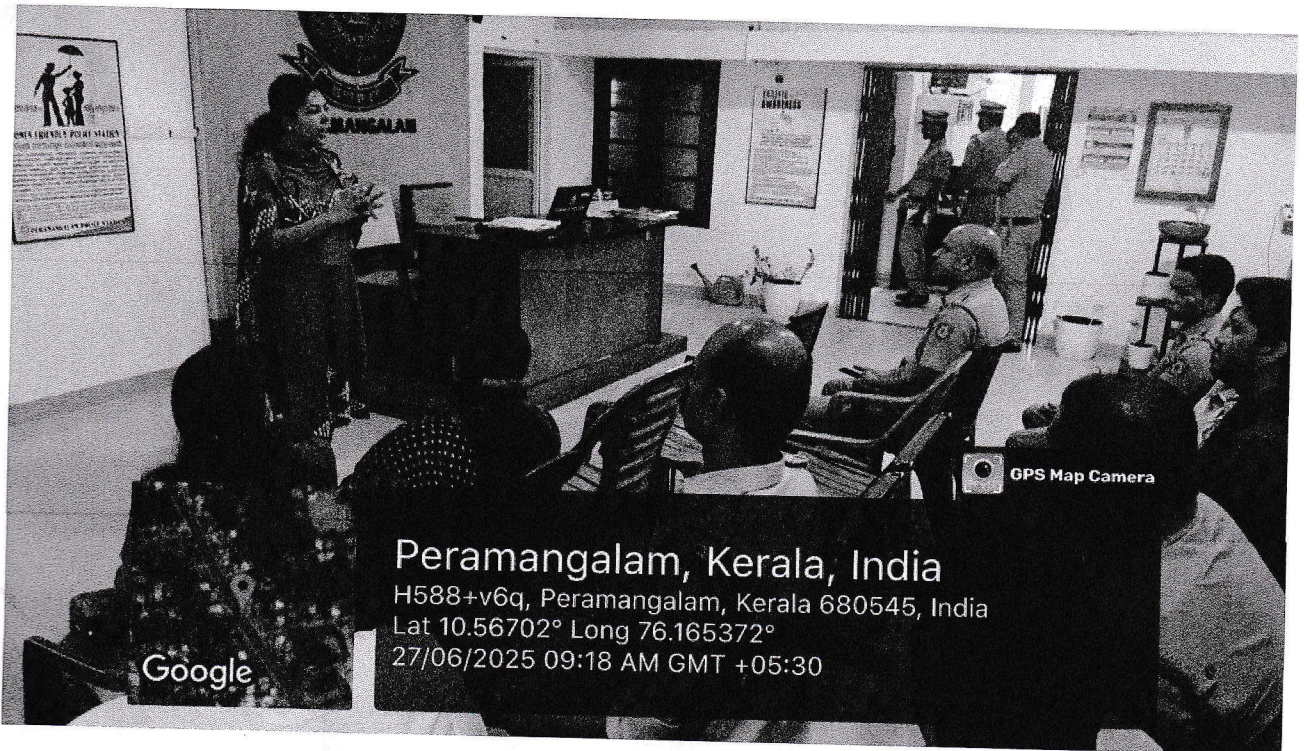
