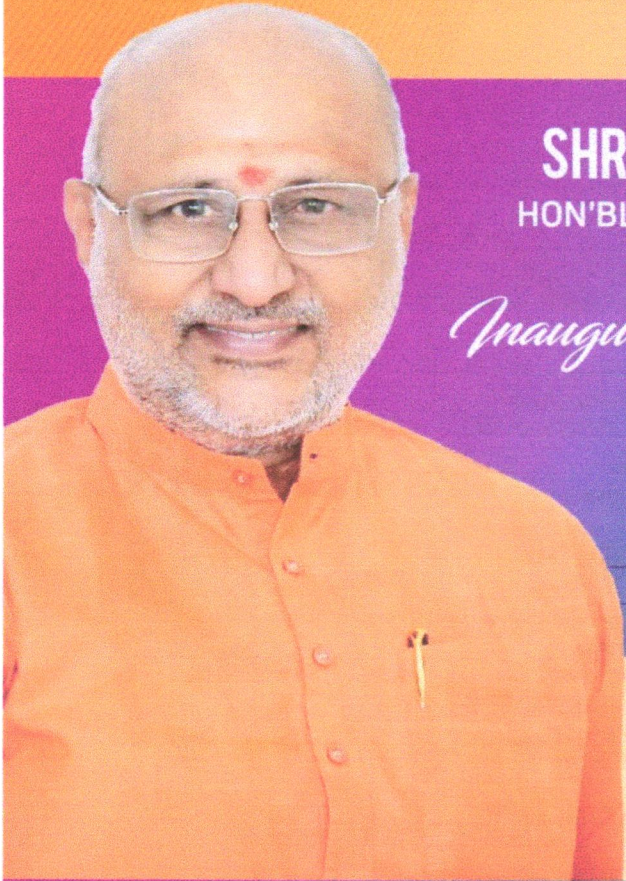

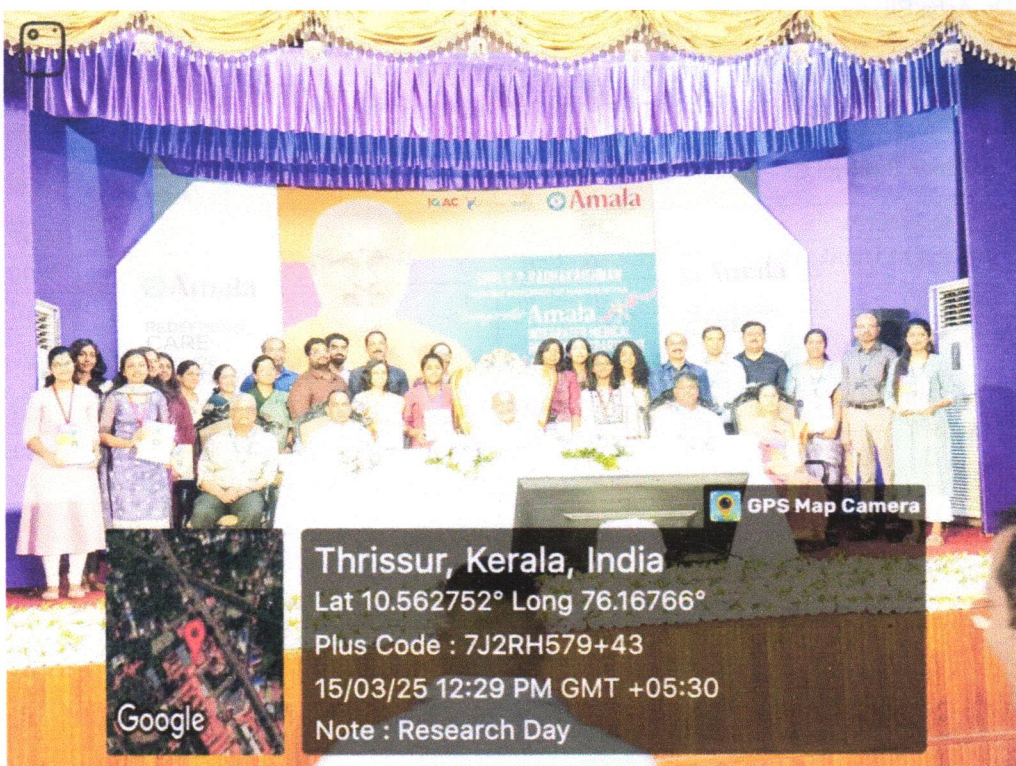

Publication Incentive Evaluation Report – 2024

Introduction


This report evaluates faculty publications for the **Publication Incentive Scheme 2024**, based on applications received on **25/11/2025** and **13/02/2025**. The selection of faculty members for incentives was determined by journal indexing and quartile rankings.

- **Quartile Calculation:** Based on CiteScore (Scopus) percentile rankings and SJR Ranking.
 - Q1 (75%–99%)
 - Q2 (50%–74%)
 - Q3 (25%–49%)
 - Q4 (0%–24%)
- **Journal Impact Factor Consideration:** Based on Clarivate Analytics (2023) for PubMed, Scopus, and WOS-indexed journals.
- **Eligible Indexing:** SCI, SCI-Expanded, and ESCI core indexing were considered for WOS-listed journals.
