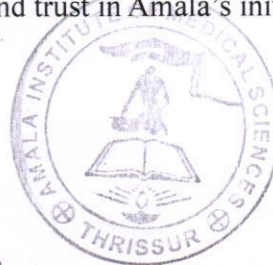

Report on Dental Screening: Amala Celebrates World Oral Health Day 2025 with Awareness and Compassionate Care



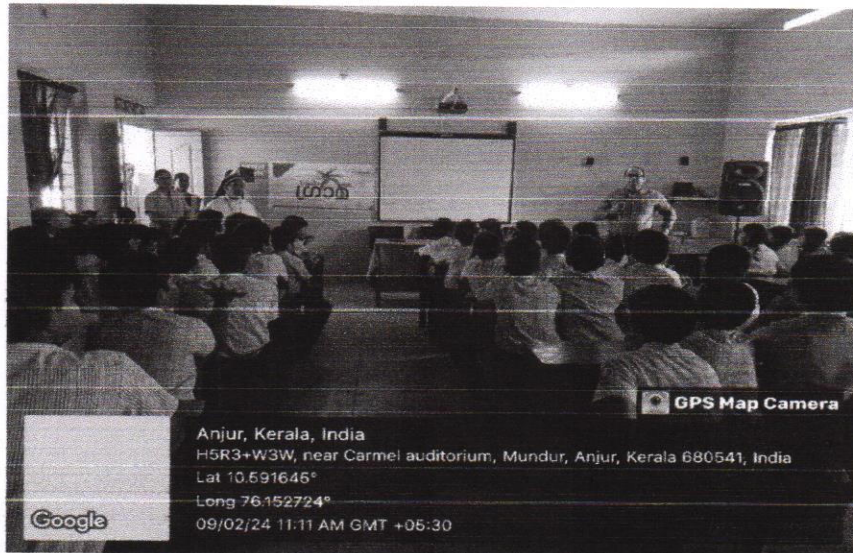


2.Toothache day awareness class
